

Year 2 Reading Fundamentals

Decoding

I can segment and blend words.
I can read words with 2 or more syllables (example – farmyard)
I can read the year 2 common exception words.
When I read familiar, age appropriate texts, I can read 94 words per minutes.

Comprehension

I can answer a copycat (retrieval) question and locate where I found my answer.
I can summarise what has been read.
I can sequence a story that I have read.
I can retell a story, referring to most of the key events, settings and characters.

Inference

I can predict what might happen next using clues from the text.
I can answer a text detective question.

Opinions

I can say why I like or dislike a text.
I am starting to give reasons that are linked to the text.
I can discuss books, poems and other texts that I have read

Building Background

I can make links between books.
I can link books to my own experience.
I am aware that books are set in different times and places.

Speaking & Listening

I can read loud enough to be heard by an audience.
