Dear Parents / Carers

Welcome back to school! I hope you were all able to spend some quality time with your children and families this summer.

We have had a great start back and I would like to thank you all for your continued support with the arrangements we have kept in place for drop off and pick up times – this will be reviewed in a couple of weeks and may continue.

Some new and exciting things happening this year at school include:

- **Voice 21** – we will be working with the **National Oracy Charity** over the next 3 years to improve teaching and learning through talk, improve children’s’ articulation, confidence and capacity to learn. [Voice 21 – The national oracy education charity](#)
- **Forest School** – we have had Miss Hunt Forest School trained and she will be implementing these outside learning approaches with children this year, which helps and facilitates more than knowledge-gathering; it helps learners develop socially, emotionally, spiritually, physically and intellectually. - **iLearning** – we will be continuing to enhance teaching and learning through the use of iPads across PKAT, with training for staff and 1-2-1 iPads in Y5 & Y6 for the children.
- **Our 6Cs Curriculum** – we developed our own 6Cs curriculum last year, based on the work by Michael Fullan et al ([What are the 6Cs and why are they important? - Book Creator app](#)), which staff will implement this year. The 6 Cs are:
  - **Character:** the qualities we need to be good learners in our world, e.g. honesty, empathy, curiosity & resilience.
  - **Critical Thinking:** using tools to evaluate information critically - is it correct / how true is it? Making connections between the different things you find out and making new knowledge / facts.
  - **Creative Thinking:** asking questions to help make new ideas and taking the lead to on make them happen.
  - **Collaboration:** learning with others as a team and part of a team, helping each other learn and learning from them, helping the team work well together, making decisions together. People skills we need to work together.
  - **Communication:** using technology, writing and speaking, effectively, for different audiences - so they can understand what is being explained.
  - **Citizenship:** thinking deeply about our world’s problems and how we can help make it a better place for everyone in it, together.
- **Commando Joe:** is the largest provider of character education in the country and has been awarded funding by the DfE to extend support for schools. [About - Commando Joe's \(commandojoes.co.uk\)](#)
- **STEPS Behaviour:** staff are being trained on these strategies to managing and supporting children’s’ behaviour to achieve positive outcomes. STEPS is a therapeutic, whole-school approach to positive behaviour management and is already established in many education settings. Training includes theory, analysis tools and planning tools that support whole-school and individual needs.

I have included with this a PDF of my welcome back assembly presentation, which we used to remind the children of what we are about at Longthorpe – PKAT.

Here's to a great year at Longthorpe and we are looking forward to your support and encouragement across the year and working with you to get the best for your children.
